2015 Course Rules

Dress Code - Men

- A. All players must have a collared shirt (Mock turtle necks are permitted)
 - 1. No tank tops
 - 2. All age of golfers will follow the collared shirt rule
- B. Early spring Cold / Rainy days
 - 1. Sweatshirts, jackets, rainwear are appropriate
- C. Any player not abiding by the collared shirt rule will be asked to leave the course.

Dress Code - Women

- 1. No shirts exposing midriff
- 2. Shorts of appropriate length and no spandex

Equipment

- A. Soft spike only
- B. Tennis shoes, sneakers are acceptable (no boots or hard soled shoes)
- C. Every player must have their own clubs

Carts & Course Damage

Must be 16 years of age and have a valid driver's license to operate a golf cart

- A. All rules posted on the first tee, in the cart and the Pro Shop must be abided by.
 - 1. Violations of cart rules could result in loss of cart privileges
- B. Course Damage (greens, tee markers etc.)
 - 1. Any reported violations of damaging the course or equipment on the course will result in cost of the repair and suspension.

Foursome Rule - May 1 - Labor Day

- A. Saturday & Sunday 9am 3pm
 - 1. You must have 4 players (3 with permission of the pro shop) to be on the golf course during these hours.

Junior Rule - June 1 - Labor Day

- A. Ages 12 & up (Grades 9 12)
 - 1. Weekdays can't start a new round or make the turn after 4:00 unless with an adult member
 - 2. Weekends & Holidays can't play until after 4:00
- B. All children under the age of 11 (Grade 8 and below)
 - 1. Same rules as above and must have an adult member with them at all times / all year.

Exceptions to the Junior Ruke:

Boys with established handicap of 25 or less & Girls with established handicap of 30 or less and have met with the Golf Professional to go over course rules.

Sign in sheet

- A. We ask that all players sign in the Pro Shop before they play.
 - 1. The reason, in case of emergency we know you are on the course.

Weekends – Friday, Saturday and Sunday / 2 Time Rule

- A. You must have a golf member in every group
- **B.** Guests are permitted to play on these days only 2 times unless they are outside of 50 miles or a member of a USGA course.
- C. Carts are mandatory for all guests on these days

New for 2015: Member only times – golf member in each group

Monday & Wednesday after 2:00, Thursday after 1:00 (during Men's league season)
